The proposed amendments update references to communications sent to licensees, registrants, and certificate holders to include email. These proposed amendments follow the passage of 2018 Va. Acts Ch. 101, which allowed the Board of Medicine to provide such communications electronically. The Board of Medicine has the statutory authority to amend these regulations under Virginia Code § 54.1-2400. The proposed amendments are constitutional and do not conflict with existing federal or state laws or regulations.
