REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE LICENSURE OF NURSE PRACTITIONERS

18 VAC 90-30-50. Fees.

Fees required in connection with the licensure of nurse practitioners are:

1. Application.....	\$50 85
2. Biennial licensure renewal.....	\$30 50
3. Reinstatement of licensure.....	\$25 95
4. Verification of licensure to another jurisdiction.....	\$25
5. Duplicate license.....	\$10 5
6. Return check charge.....	\$15 25
7. Replacement wall certificate.....	\$15
8. Late fee.....	\$20
9. Reinstatement after suspension or revocation.....	\$125

18 VAC 90-30-110. Reinstatement of license.

A. A licensed nurse practitioner whose license has lapsed may be reinstated within one renewal period by payment of the current renewal fee and the late fee.

~~A B. An applicant for reinstatement of lapsed license~~ A licensed nurse practitioner whose license has lapsed for more than one renewal period shall

- 1. File the required application and reinstatement fee;
- 2. Be currently licensed as a registered nurse in Virginia; and
- 3. Provide evidence of current professional certification or, if applicable, licensure or certification in another jurisdiction.

~~B C. An applicant for reinstatement of license following suspension or revocation~~ A licensed nurse practitioner whose license has been suspended or revoked and who is seeking reinstatement by the board shall:

- 1. ~~Petition for~~ File a reinstatement application and pay the fee for reinstatement after suspension or revocation;
- 2. Present evidence that he is currently licensed as a registered nurse in Virginia; and
- 3. Present evidence that he is competent to resume practice as a licensed nurse practitioner in Virginia.

D. The committee shall act on the petition pursuant to the Administrative Process Act, § 9-6.14:1 et seq. of the Code of Virginia.
