The Board of Nursing has amended regulations to reduce biennial renewal fees for the renewal years of 2017-19. The renewal for a registered nurse will be reduced from \$140 to \$105; the renewal fee for a licensed practical nurse will be reduced from \$120 to \$90. Renewal fees for all professions are reduced by approximately 25% with the exception of certified nurse aides. The Board is not allowed by federal law to charge a fee for placing a CNA on the registry, so without

application fees, revenue from renewal fees does not cover the cost of regulating and disciplining the profession.
