This action will repeal Virginia's *Texas Hold'em Poker Tournament Regulations* (11 VAC 15-50 *et seq.*) and is necessary to conform the Virginia Administrative Code to a mandate of the General Assembly. The agency has no discretion in this matter.

The Charitable Gaming Board promulgated the *Texas Hold'em Poker Tournament Regulations*, which was published in the Virginia Register of Regulations on April 12, 2021, with an effective date of March 23, 2021. Item 105 of the 2021 Appropriation Act (Chapter 552, 2021 Acts of Assembly, Special Session I) provided that all regulations promulgated by the Charitable Gaming Board and in effect on March 1, 2021, shall remain in force and no additional regulations shall be promulgated. The third enactment of both Chapters 554 and 609 of the 2022 Acts of Assembly provides that "the regulations promulgated by the Charitable Gaming Board regarding Texas Hold'em poker games and tournaments, which became effective on March 23, 2021,...shall not take effect."

Chapters 554 and 609 of the 2022 Acts of Assembly also (i) amended Section 3.2-102 of the Code of Virginia (Code) to authorize the Commissioner of Agriculture and Consumer Services to promulgate regulations not inconsistent with the laws of Virginia necessary to carry out the provisions of the Charitable Gaming Law (Article 1.1:1 of Chapter 8 of Title 18.2 of the Code) and (ii) eliminated the provisions of the Code that authorized the Charitable Gaming Board to promulgate regulations.

Mandate and Impetus

The third enactment of both Chapters 554 and 609 of the 2022 Acts of Assembly provides that "the regulations promulgated by the Charitable Gaming Board regarding Texas Hold'em poker games and tournaments, which became effective on March 23, 2021,...shall not take effect." This regulatory action to repeal *Texas Hold'em Poker Tournament Regulations* is necessary to conform to changes in Virginia statutory law and no agency discretion is involved and, as such, is exempt from the requirements of Article 2 of Chapter 40 of Title 2.2 of the Code pursuant to Section 2.2-4006(A)(4)(a) of the Code.

On September 10, 2022, the Commissioner of Agriculture and Consumer Services repealed the *Texas Hold'em Poker Tournament Regulations*, 11 VAC 15-50 *et seg.*
