This action will repeal the Charitable Gaming Board's *Charitable Gaming Regulations*, 11 VAC 15-40, in accordance with the provisions of Chapters 554 and 609 of the 2022 Acts of Assembly.

Chapters 554 and 609 of the 2022 Acts of Assembly provide, in part, that the regulations of the Charitable Gaming Board shall be administered by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services and shall remain in full force and effect until the Commissioner of Agriculture and Consumer Services promulgates regulations. The Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services is currently conducting a separate regulatory action to promulgate *Charitable Gaming Regulations*, 11 VAC 20-20, which will consist of the regulatory requirements in 11 VAC 15-40 and new provisions regarding electronic gaming. The repeal of 11 VAC 15-40 and the promulgation of 11 VAC 20-20 will have the same effective date.

Mandate and Impetus

Chapters 554 and 609 of the 2022 Acts of Assembly (i) eliminated the provisions of the Code of Virginia that authorized the Charitable Gaming Board (Board) to promulgate regulations, (ii) reclassified the Board as an advisory board within the meaning of Va. Code § 2.2-2100, and (iii) authorized the Commissioner of Agriculture and Consumer Services to promulgate regulations to carry out the provisions of the Charitable Gaming Law (Article 1.1:1 of Chapter 8 of Title 18.2 of the Code). Chapters 554 and 609 of the 2022 Acts of Assembly further provide that the regulations of the Charitable Gaming Board shall be administered by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services and shall remain in full force and effect until the Commissioner of Agriculture and Consumer Services promulgates regulations in accordance with Chapters 554 and 609.

The agency has no discretion in this custodial action to repeal the Board's *Charitable Gaming Regulations*, 11 VAC 15-40, and this regulatory action is necessary to conform to the provisions of Chapters 554 and 609 of the 2022 Acts of Assembly. As such, the repeal of this regulation is exempt from requirements of Article 2 of Chapter 40 of Title 2.2 of the Code pursuant to Section 2.2-4006(A)(4)(a) of the Code.
