SUBJECT: Authority to Amend Compulsory Minimum Training Standards for Jailers or Custodial Officers,

Courthouse and Courtroom Security Officers, and Process Server Officers.

In response to a request from the Department of Criminal Justice Services, I am of the opinion that the Department has the legal authority to amend the compulsory minimum training standards for jailers or custodial officers, courthouse and courtroom security officers, and process server officers. These standards are set forth in 6 VAC 20-50-10 *et seq*. The Department's authority to amend the standards is derived from Virginia Code § 9.1-102(7), (8), and (9), which gives the Department, under the Criminal Justice Services Board, the power and duty to establish compulsory minimum entry-level, in service, and advanced training standards for all such persons.

Upon review of the aforesaid regulations, and in accordance with Executive Order 21 (2002), I find the proposed regulations to be constitutional, consistent with the authority granted by § 9.1-102 of the Code of Virginia, and in conformity with existing statutory provisions.
