The Governor's 2012 Regulatory Reform Initiative was established to repeal regulations that are unnecessary or no longer in use. This chapter was replaced on July 13, 1994 with 6VAC20-170: Regulations Relating to Private Security Services, which included the training standards for Private Security Services Business Personnel. 6VAC20-110 was never repealed and since that time, 6VAC20-170 was repealed on February 2, 2000 and replaced with 6VAC20-171: Regulations Relating to Private Security Services, which are currently in effect. The regulations within chapter 6VAC20-110 have not been in use since 1994

The Department of Criminal Justice Services is taking final action to repeal the Rules Relating to Training Standards for Private Security Services Business Personnel 6VAC20-110 on July 2, 2013.

The Governor's 2012 Regulatory Reform Initiative instructed all agencies to conduct a comprehensive review of regulations currently in place and repeal regulations that are unnecessary or no longer in use. These regulations have been replaced by current regulations promulgated pursuant to §9.1-141 of the Code of Virginia, and in accordance with the Code of Virginia §2.2-4012.1.
