12VAC30-70-351. Updating rates for inflation.

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Each July, the DRI-Virginia moving average values as compiled and published by

DRI/McGraw-Hill under contract with the department shall be used to update the base

year standardized operating costs per case, as determined in 12VAC30-70-361, and the

base year standardized operating costs per day, as determined in 12VAC30-70-371, to the

midpoint of the upcoming state fiscal year. The most current table available prior to the

effective date of the new rates shall be used to inflate base year amounts to the upcoming

rate year. Thus, corrections made by DRI/McGraw-Hill in the moving averages that were

used to update rates for previous state fiscal years shall be automatically incorporated

into the moving averages that are being used to update rates for the upcoming state fiscal

year. In setting rates effective from July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004, for Type II

hospitals, the moving average value that would normally be used to represent inflation

occurring from the midpoint of SFY2003 to the midpoint of SFY2004, shall be replaced

by a percentage calculated by DMAS to ensure that the resulting estimated increase in

payments to hospitals, by Medicaid, does not exceed \$10,863,375 in SFY2004.
