Recent legislation passed during the 2024 legislative session is the impetus for this regulatory action. <u>Chapter 135 of the 2024 Acts of Assembly</u> amends Code of Virginia to update <u>§45.2-1200</u> the prohibited use of cyanide or cyanide compound in mineral mining or processing operations. This action aims to update the Admin Code of Virginia to match the updated Code of Virginia language.

Mandate and Impetus
