Chapter 47 of the 2013 Acts of Assembly repealed Chapter 17 of Title 45.1 of the Code of Virginia. That chapter was superseded by Chapter 19, the Virginia Coal Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act of 1979. There are no longer any permits outstanding under Chapter 17. Thus, the attendant regulations are also obsolete. This action repeals those regulations in the Virginia Administrative Code. This action is submitted as part of Governor McDonnell's Regulatory Reform Initiative.
