3 **18VAC120-10-100. Definitions.**

- 4 The following words and terms, when used in this chapter, shall have the following meanings
- 5 unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 6 "Agency" means the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation.
- 7 "Organization" means any one or more associations, advisory council, committee, corporation,
- 8 partnership, governmental body or legal entity.
- 9 "Person" means one or more individuals.
- 10

11 **18VAC120-10-110. Mailing list.**

- 12 The agency will maintain a list of persons and organizations who will be mailed the following
- 13 documents as they become available:
- 14 1. "Notice of Intended Regulatory Action" to promulgate, amend or repeal regulations.
- 15 2. "Notice of Comment Period" and public hearings.
- 16 3. Notice that the final regulations have been adopted.
- 17 Failure of these persons and organizations to receive the documents for any reason shall not
- 18 affect the validity of any regulations otherwise properly adopted under the Administrative
- 19 Process Act, Chapter 1.1:1 (§<u>9-6.14:1</u> et seq.) of Title 9 of the Code of Virginia.
- 20

21 **18VAC120-10-120.** Placement on the mailing list; deletion.

- Any person wishing to be placed on the mailing list may do so by writing the agency. In
- addition, the agency at its discretion, may add to the list any person, organization, or publication
- 24 it believes will serve the purpose of responsible participation in the formation or promulgation of
- regulations. Persons on the list will be provided all information stated in 18VAC120-10-110.
- 26 Individuals and organizations periodically may be requested to indicate their desire to continue
- 27 to receive documents or be deleted from the list. When mail is returned as undeliverable,
- 28 individuals and organizations will be deleted from the list.

30 **18VAC120-10-130.** Petition for rulemaking.

- 31 Any person may petition the agency to adopt or amend any regulation. Any petition received
- 32 shall appear on the next agenda of the agency. The agency shall consider and respond to the
- petition within 180 days. The agency shall have sole authority to dispose of the petition.

35 **18VAC120-10-140.** Notice of intent.

- 36 At least 30 days prior to filing the "Notice of Comment Period" and proposed regulations as
- 37 required by <u>§9-6.14:7.1</u> of the Code of Virginia, the agency will publish a "Notice of Intended
- Regulatory Action." This notice will provide for at least a 30-day comment period and shall state
- 39 whether the agency intends to hold a public hearing. The agency is required to hold a hearing on
- 40 the proposed regulation upon request by (i) the Governor or (ii) 25 or more persons. Further, the
- 41 notice shall describe the subject matter and intent of the planned regulation. Such notice shall be
- 42 transmitted to the Registrar of Regulations for inclusion in The Virginia Register of Regulations.

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18VAC120-10-150. Informational proceedings or public hearings for existing rules.

- 3 Within two years of the promulgation of a regulation, the agency shall evaluate it for
- 4 effectiveness and continued need. The agency shall conduct an informal proceeding, which may
- 5 take the form of a public hearing, to receive public comment on existing regulation. Notice of
- 6 such proceedings shall be transmitted to the Registrar of Regulations for inclusion in The
- 7 Virginia Register. Such proceedings may be held separately or in conjunction with other
- 8 informational proceedings.

10 **18VAC120-10-160.** Notice of formulation and adoption.

- 11 At any meeting of the agency or a subcommittee where it is anticipated the formation or adoption
- 12 of regulation will occur, the subject matter shall be transmitted to the Registrar of Regulations
- 13 for inclusion in The Virginia Register.
- 14 If there are one or more changes with substantial impact on a regulation, any person may petition
- 15 the agency within 30 days from the publication of the final regulation to request an opportunity
- 16 for oral or written submittals on the changes to the regulations. If the agency receives requests
- 17 from at least 25 persons for an opportunity to make oral or written comment, the agency shall
- suspend the regulatory process for 30 days to solicit additional public comment, unless the
- 19 agency determines that the changes made are minor or inconsequential in their impact.
- 20 If the Governor finds that one or more changes with substantial impact have been made to
- 21 proposed regulation, he may suspend the regulatory process for 30 days to require the agency to 22 solicit further public comment on the changes to the regulation.
- A draft of the agency's summary description of public comment shall be sent by the agency to all
- 24 public commenters on the proposed regulation at least five days before final adoption of the
- 25 regulation.

27 18VAC120-10-170. Advisory committees.

- 28 The agency intends to appoint advisory committees <u>or task forces ("committees")</u> as it deems
- necessary to provide adequate participation in the formation, promulgation, adoption, and review
- 30 of regulations. Such committees are particularly appropriate when other interested parties may
- 31 possess specific expertise in the area of proposed regulation. The advisory committee
- 32 <u>committees</u> shall only provide recommendations to the agency and shall not participate in any
- 33 final decision making actions on a regulation.
- 34 When identifying potential advisory committee members the agency may use the following:
- 1. Directories of organizations related to the profession,
- 36 2. Industry, professional and trade associations' mailing lists, and
- 37 3. Lists of persons who have previously participated in public proceedings concerning this or a
- 38 related issue.
- 39

40 **18VAC120-10-180.** Applicability.

- 41 18VAC120-10-110, 18VAC120-10-120, 18VAC120-10-130, 18VAC120-10-150 and
- 42 18VAC120-10-160 shall apply to all regulations promulgated and adopted in accordance with

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<u>\$9-6.14:9</u> of the Code of Virginia except those regulations promulgated in accordance with <u>\$9-6.14:4.1</u> of the Administrative Process Act.

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
