Section 19VAC30-2—80 of the Virginia Regulations is being amended to bring Virginia into compliance with the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations promulgated by the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, with amendments promulgated June 1, 2020 and effective September 29, 2020, pursuant to the United States Motor Carrier Safety Act found in 49 CFR Part 385 and 49 CFR 395 as amended by 85 FR 33396-33452 published 6/1/2020

These regulations are mandated by §52-8.4 and 49 CFR Part 390. The impetus for this regulation are the June 1, 2020 amendments to 49 CFR Parts 385 and 395 of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations promulgated by the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, and effective September 29, 2020. The amendments were published June 1, 2020 in the Federal register at 85 FR 33396-33452.

On June 16, 2020, the Virginia State Police adopted final amended regulations for 19 VAC 30-20, the Motor Carrier Safety Regulations. The amendments alter section 19VAC30-20-80 as follows:

19VAC30-80-20 was updated to incorporate changes to the Federal Motor Carrier Safety regulations in effect on and after September 29, 2020. This will include the changes to Hours of Service allowed for drivers under 49 CFR Parts 385 and 395 as amended in 2020.
