Chapters 36 and 152 (HB1825/SB1005) of the Acts of Assembly of 2011 made various amendments to the *Code of Virginia* relating to the office of Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner. Some of these amendments affected the duties involved in making formal reports to the General Assembly, transferring roads between the primary and secondary systems, road abandonments and discontinuances, and conveyances of property. These chapters also replaced the formal title used for VDOT's chief executive officer (Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner) with a new title (Commissioner of Highways). References to the Commissioner's title in the *Public Participation Guidelines* and other regulatory references in the Virginia Administrative Code (VAC) are being updated through this regulatory action.

The Office of the Attorney General has determined that Chapters 36 and 152 require these obsolete references be updated. Statutory authority and the titles for each regulatory reference in the VAC is included in Tables A and B on the next page. This action is exempt from Article 2 of the APA under § 2.2-4006 (A) (4) (a), because it is necessary to comply with a change in state law.
