**Subject:** Letter of Assurance for APELSCIDLA Board Amended Regulations

I have reviewed the Proposed Amendments to the Board for Architects, Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors, Certified Interior Designers and Landscape Architects Regulations posted on Town Hall on October 20, 2004. In my view, as counsel to the APELSCIDLA Board, the Board may promulgate these amendments to its regulations pursuant to § 54.1-201(5) of the Code of Virginia and the proposed regulations do not appear to conflict with the Constitutions of the United States or the Commonwealth of Virginia, nor do they conflict with any federal or state law.
