~~8VAC 20-400-10. Salary.~~

~~On and after July, 1980, salaries of division superintendents will be computed as follows:~~

~~1980-81 1981-82 (a) If employed full time in a school division \$11,000 \$11,500 with a school population of not less than 3,000 shall receive a minimum salary of (b) If employed full time in a school division \$10,000 \$10,500 with a school population of more than 2,000 but less than 3,000 shall receive a minimum salary of (c) If employed full time in a school division \$ 9,600 \$10,100 with a school population of less than 2,000, shall receive a minimum salary of~~

~~In school divisions with a school population of more than 3,000, the division superintendent shall receive, in addition to the minimum of \$11,000 and \$11,500, \$10 for each 100 school population above 3,000, allowing in each computation 50 pupils or more to count as the next higher even hundred.~~

~~8VAC 20-400-20. State and local share.~~

~~The state shall contribute 60% of the amounts prescribed in 8VAC 20-400-10, and 40% shall be paid from local funds.~~

~~8VAC 20-400-30. Part-time superintendent.~~

~~Approval of the Board of Education must be secured for the employment of a part-time superintendent and the board must approve the conditions under which the part-time superintendent may be employed and the amount of salary to be fixed for services rendered as division superintendent. Such salary shall be paid by the state and the county or city, respectively, in the same proportion as stated above.~~

~~8VAC 20-400-40. Method of payment.~~

~~The amounts to be contributed by the state as provided above will be paid by the state treasurer in monthly installments out of the available funds on the warrants of the comptroller upon the approved voucher or vouchers required by the comptroller. The monthly installments will be made payable to the appropriate school board and such board shall have the duty of combining the necessary local funds each month with the state funds, deducting from the combined total all deductions required by law or otherwise authorized, and paying the net proceeds thereof in monthly installments to the division superintendent and part-time superintendent, if any.~~

~~8VAC 20-400-50. Local supplement.~~

~~The local school board may supplement the salary prescribed above out of local funds. The local school board shall provide for the necessary traveling and office expenses of the superintendent. Detailed records of all such expenses shall be kept in the office of the superintendent.~~
