Re: Regulations Governing Standards for State-Funded Remedial Programs Participation (8 VAC 20-630-10 et seq.)

Dear Dr. Wright:

You ask whether the Board of Education possesses the requisite authority to amend the above-referenced regulations.

Section 22.1-16 vests the Board of Education with the authority to promulgate such regulations as may be necessary to carry out its powers and duties and the provisions of Title 22.1. In addition, § 22.1-199.2 specifically requires regulations in this area. Chapter 61 of the 2010 Acts of Assembly amended § 22.1-199.2 to remove certain reports previously required of local school boards. The proposed amendment to the regulation simply brings the regulation into compliance with the amended law. Thus, the Board's action in amending the regulation is exempt from Article 2 of the Administrative Process Act by virtue of § 2.2-4006.A.4.a. Accordingly, it is my view that the Board possesses the requisite authority to adopt and amend the above-referenced regulations.
