SUBJECT: Amendments to VAC 20-131-80, 20-131-150: Amendments to Regulations

Establishing Standards for Accrediting Public Schools as required by Chapter 582 of the 2020 Acts of Assembly (minimum instruction time for

kindergarten)

I have reviewed the amendments to the regulations identified above in order to determine whether the State Board of Education (Board) has the authority to promulgate the regulations and if the regulations comport with applicable state law.

Pursuant to § 22.1-16 of the *Code of Virginia*, the Board has authority to promulgate regulations to carry out its statutory powers and duties. In addition, pursuant to § 22.1-253.13:3 of the *Code of Virginia*, the Board of Education has the authority to promulgate regulations related to establishing standards for accrediting public schools.

It is my view that this regulatory action is exempt from Article 2 of the Administrative Process Act by virtue of § 2.2-4006.A.4.a, as this change is "[n]ecessary to

conform to changes in Virginia statutory law or the appropriation act where no agency discretion is involved." This change is mandated by Chapter 582 of the 2020 Acts of Assembly. It is further my view that this action remains subject to Governor Executive Order 14 (2018)¹, and that the Board has not exceeded its authority.

¹ This Executive Order has been replaced by Executive Order 19 (2022), which by its terms applies to regulatory activity initiated on or after July 1, 2022. The subject regulation was initiated prior to July 1, 2022, and so is not governed by E0 19 (2022).
