

10-7.1 <u>POLICY</u> Section <u>2.2-4318</u> of the <u>Code of Virginia</u> permits a public body to negotiate with an apparent low bidder if the bid exceeds available funds. Such negotiation may be undertaken only under conditions and procedures described in the "Agency Procurement Surplus Property Manual" published by Virginia Department of General Services/Division of Purchasing and Supply.

Negotiations shall be designed to bring the bidder into the range of available Department funds. Negotiations shall not result in these funds being exceeded.
