The regulation establishes the rules and regulations for use of the Virginia Quality Label, whenever producers or processors of any Virginia agricultural or food products want to participate in the label program. The details of the Virginia Quality Label program are contained in §§ 3.1-349 through 3.1-360 of the Code of Virginia, which provide a means to identify through a label those agricultural or food products that have been processed, packed, prepared, or dressed under continuous official inspection by the agency.

Basis

Section 3.1-352 of the Code of Virginia specifies that the Director of the Division of Marketing is to adopt rules and regulations governing the use of the Virginia Quality Label. It states that the label "shall not be used except in accordance with the rules and regulations;" therefore, the regulations are mandatory for effective use of the label.

The agency received no public comment on this regulation as the result of the Notice of Periodic Review published in The Virginia Register of Regulations on June 18, 2001, to provide notice of opportunity to comment on this regulation pursuant to Executive Order Number Twenty-five (98). No informal advisory group was formed for the purposes of assisting in the periodic review.

Effectiveness

The specific and measurable goals of the regulation are:

1. The protection of the public's health, safety, and welfare with the least possible cost and

intrusiveness to the citizens and businesses of the Commonwealth.

2. To provide to those who choose to participate in the Virginia Quality Label program a tool that may be used to promote the sales of certain Virginia agricultural products (specifically, those processed, packed, prepared, or dressed under continuous official inspection by the agency).

There have been no requests from industry to make use of the Virginia Quality Label for more than twenty years. However, the regulation provides the rules that are required by the Code should a segment of the agriculture industry develop a need to use the label to designate the level of quality that is supported by continuous official inspection by the agency. If such a need arises that cannot be satisfied by other quality identification programs currently in use, then the regulation could enable use of the quality label to relieve the concerns of buyers. This could lead to economic benefits for the welfare of citizens that would come from maintaining or increasing sales.

The regulation has no impact on the institution of the family and family stability.

It is clearly written and easily understandable by the individuals and entities who may be affected.

Alternatives

The agency has considered repealing the regulation because alternative programs that are less burdensome are available and currently in use. However, the program has been retained for use should a segment of industry develop a need, which cannot be met by other programs, to officially designate through a Virginia Quality Label that a product has undergone continuous official inspection by the agency.

Recommendation

Since participation in this program is not required and the program is intended only for those who request it because they have identified a need for it, and since there have been no requests for changes, the agency recommends that the regulation should stay in effect without change.
