# **NOTES ON THIS FORM**

The Citizen Cemetery Recordation Form is designed to easily allow members of the public (not archaeologists or preservation professionals) to submit information relating to many different kinds of cemeteries throughout Virginia. By submitting this form to DHR, you are recording a cemetery in our historic resources database. This information may be accessed by researchers, or by individuals, governments, and agencies seeking compliance with State and Federal preservation laws. In other words, recording a cemetery with DHR may help prevent it from being damaged or destroyed. To further ensure the preservation of a cemetery, contact the Assessor's office of your local government to ensure that the cemetery is recorded on local-level parcel maps.

Recording a cemetery on this form does not "list" it on the National Register of Historic Places or the Virginia Landmarks Register or affirm its historical significance. For more information on listing resources on the historic registers, contact DHR's regional staff.

### **ACCOMPANYING MATERIALS INFORMATION**

Submit the following materials to DHR's Archives along with this completed form.

#### 1 Locator map

Locator map will preferably be a relevant portion of a 7.5' USGS Topographic Quadrangle Map. Indicate location of cemetery and the name of the USGS Quad. Print or digital formats accepted. Free digital topo maps are available from <u>the USGS website</u>. Printouts or digital images of legible maps similar to Mapquest or Google Maps may also be acceptable. Ensure that the size, shape, and location of your cemetery is visible on the map. You may need to provide two maps (one far away to show location and one zoomed in to show size and shape) to allow us to adequately record your cemetery.

#### 2. Plan drawing of the cemetery

Plan view drawing may be computer generated or hand-drawn. Drawing must show outline of the cemetery and placement of headstones/depressions from an overhead view.

#### 3. Photos

Black and white archival prints no larger than 4" x 6" are preferred. Digital image files (.TIF) will be accepted in all circumstances.
