MINUTE NO. 1 Fast-track amendment to the Closure Plan and Demonstration of Financial Capability (9VAC25-650 et seq.) regulation

Melissa Porterfield presented the State Water Control Board (Board) with a fast-track amendment to the Closure Plan and Demonstration of Financial Capability (9VAC25-650 et seq.) regulation. This fast-track regulatory action changes the timing of when financial assurance is required to be provided when a permit is transferred to a new owner or operator.

The Board was asked to approve the use of the fast-track process and to adopt the amendments to the Closure Plan and Demonstration of Financial Capability (9VAC25-650 et seq.) regulation as a final regulation.

Board Decision

Based on the briefing materials and the staff presentation, the Board voted unanimously to authorize the Department of Environmental Quality (Department) to:

- 1. Promulgate the proposal for public comment using the fast-track process established in § 2.2-4012.1 of the Administrative Process Act for regulations expected to be non-controversial. The Board's authorization should also be understood to constitute its adoption of the amendments to the Closure Plan and Demonstration of Financial Capability (9VAC25-650 et seq.) regulation at the end of the public comment period provided that (i) no objection to use of the fast-track process is received from 10 or more persons, or any member of the applicable standing committee of either house of the General Assembly or of the Joint Commission on Administrative Rules, and (ii) the Department does not find it necessary, based on public comments or for any other reason, to make any changes to the proposal.
- 2. Set an effective date 15 days after close of the 30-day public comment period provided (i) the proposal completes the fast-track rulemaking process as provided in § 2.2-4012.1 of the Administrative Process Act and (ii) the Department does not find it necessary to make any changes to the proposal.

Prior to the meeting, the Board was provided briefing materials which included a revised draft of the subject general permit regulation, the fact sheet for the general permit, the Agency Background Document (TH-09) which included the public comment and the agency response, and the Technical Advisory Committee Membership. Jaime Robb from the Office of Stormwater Management presented a summary of changes from the proposed regulation that were made in response to public comment.

During the public comment portion of the presentation to the Board, the following three speakers addressed the Board: Lisa Ochsenhirt (Representing the Virginia Municipal Stormwater Association), Freed Cathcart, and Mara Robbins. Ms. Ochsenhirt spoke in favor of approving the permit regulation. Ms. Cathcart and Ms. Robbins expressed opposition to the proposed permit regulation.
