The Committee reconvened in open session at 10:32 A.M.

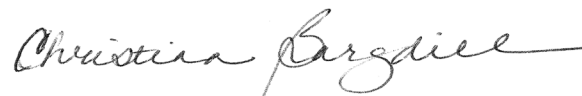

As provided by law, this decision shall become Final Order thirty (30) days after service of such order on Ms. Long unless a written request to the Board for a formal hearing on the allegations made against her is received from Ms. Long within such time. If service of the order is made by mail, three (3) additional days shall be added to that period. Upon such timely request for a formal hearing, the Order shall be vacated.
