LLC recorded the proceedings.

WITNESSES PRESENT: Diane Marsh, Senior Investigator, Enforcement Division, was present and
testified.

CLOSED MEETING: Ms. Acuna moved that the Committee of the Joint Boards of Nursing and
Medicine convene a closed meeting pursuant to Section 2.2- 3711(A)(28)
of the *Code of Virginia* at 2:10 P.M. for the purpose of deliberation to reach
a decision in the matter of **Olusegun Taiwo**. Additionally, Ms. Acuna
moved that Ms. Morris, Dr. Mangrum Ms. Claiborne, and Mr. Saunders,
Board Counsel, attend the closed meeting because their presence in the
closed meeting is deemed necessary, and their presence will aid the
Committee in its deliberations. The motion was properly seconded by Dr.
Clements and the motion carried unanimously.

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RECONVENTION: The Committee reconvened in open session at 3:01 P.M.

Ms. Acuna moved that the Committee of the Joint Boards of Nursing and Medicine certify that it heard, discussed or considered only public business matters lawfully exempted from open meeting requirements under the Virginia Freedom of Information Act and only such public business matters as were identified in the motion by which the closed meeting was convened. The motion was properly seconded by Mr. Marchese and the motion carried unanimously.

ACTION: Mr. Marchese moved to indefinitely suspend with terms no less than 6 months the license of **Olusegun Taiwo** to practice as an advanced practice registered nurse in the Commonwealth of Virginia. The motion was seconded by Dr. Vaughan and carried unanimously.

This decision shall be effective upon entry of a written Order stating the findings, conclusions, and decision of this formal hearing committee.
