I. Call to Order

Chairman Craig Branch called the meeting of the Executive Committee of the Criminal Justice Services Board (CJSB) to order at 10:10 a.m. A quorum was present.

The Executive Committee is now authorized to hold the appeal sessions in a duly convened closed meeting.
