

MEETING MINUTES

CHIPAC Executive Subcommittee Meeting July 19, 2024 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

A quorum of the CHIPAC Executive Subcommittee attended this all-virtual meeting. The meeting link was posted on the Virginia Regulatory Town Hall website to allow the public to attend virtually.

Welcome – Freddy Mejia, CHIPAC Chair

Freddy Mejia, CHIPAC Chair, called the meeting to order at 10:02am. Mejia commented that the day's agenda was brief and the meeting would likely conclude early.

I. CHIPAC Business

A. Review and approval of minutes from previous meeting

Members reviewed the minutes from the April 19 Executive Subcommittee meeting. Emily Moore introduced a motion to approve the minutes, Mejia seconded, and the Subcommittee voted unanimously to approve.

B. Membership Updates

Emily Roller, DMAS staff, noted that Mejia had elected to renew his CHIPAC membership for another 2-year term. Mejia indicated plans to invite two Full Committee members to

join the Subcommittee, in an effort to deepen its knowledge base. No vote is needed to affirm membership on the Executive Subcommittee.

Victoria Richardson from the Virginia Poverty Law Center will begin her 2-year term in September.

II. Planning for the September 2024 Full Committee Meeting

The Subcommittee discussed agenda topics for the September 5 full Committee meeting. Since the meeting will occur shortly after Virginia students return to school, Moore proposed a joint presentation by the Virginia Department of Education and the Virginia Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services on schoolbased services (to include both school-based health centers and Medicaid billing).

The Subcommittee expressed a desire for a final lookback on children's coverage transitions during the "unwinding" of the Medicaid continuous coverage (return to normal enrollment).

The Subcommittee requested a presentation by DMAS staff regarding key upcoming (2025 – 26) provisions within recent U.S. Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) final rules, and a brief preview of provisions occurring further in the future.

III. Public Comment

Mejia invited public comment but none was made.
