2. Review and Approval of Minutes

The November meeting minutes were approved with no changes.

3. Reports/Announcements:

Mr. Burdette updated the board and attendees on aviation issues and activities across the Commonwealth. The presentation topics included DOAV's ISO-9000 Certification and enterprise risk management approach, advanced aviation systems, NextGen and Early Implementation Program, upcoming Aviation Safety Week April 26-29, economic impact study and development opportunities, workforce development, DOAV's FY10 funding budget. b. FAA Report ...... Terry Page, FAA

Mr. Page announced the upcoming 33<sup>rd</sup> Annual Airport Conference 2010 on March 2-4 in Hershey, Pennsylvania. Mr. Page shared information on an FAA pilot program for sustainability planning as part of an airport master plan or a stand alone planning project. He had nothing to report on the airport stimulus funding; FAA is still waiting to hear details on any proposed stimulus program. Mr. Page mentioned that the Airport Improvement Program Part A has \$2 billion, and he encourages sponsors to submit project requests while funding is available.

c. VAOC Report ...... Juan Rivera, VAOC

Mr. Rivera updated the board and attendees on VAOC activities, which included sponsorship for the VABA legislative reception, participation in an upcoming *Airport Program Manual* review, and a website update. The Spring Workshop will be held April 28 and 29 in Staunton; the workshop committee has a full agenda planned. The next meeting will be held as part of the Spring Workshop on April 29. Mr. Rivera gave a presentation on how recent snow storms affected several airports in Virginia.
