1. Call to Order John V. Mazza, Jr.

Chairman

The chairman called the meeting to order at 9:45 a.m.

5. Reports/Announcements:

a. DOAV Report

Randall Burdette DOAV

Mr. Burdette updated the board and attendees on aviation issues and activities across the Commonwealth. The presentation topics included approaches at every airport, upcoming legislative proposals including FOIA regulations, AWOS installations, and air taxi promotion. He announced that the November Virginia Aviation Board Meeting will be held in Northern Virginia in conjunction with the 50th anniversary of the Washington Dulles International Airport.

b. VAOC Report

L. William Kelly, President VAOC

Mr. Kelly announced that Aviation Day at the General Assembly will be held on February 7, 2013. The VAOC is currently developing its legislative agenda for 2013. The VAOC will be conducting a maintenance workshop in late November.

c. FAA Report

Terry J. Page FAA WADO

Mr. Page briefed the board on FY-2012 AIP. This is the first year of a four-year authorization with an appropriation of \$3.35 billion. This authorization allows flexibility for multiyear grants and also allows airports to combine carryover entitlements with future funds. To date, the WADO office has issued \$43,000,000 in grants. Mr. Page reminded sponsors that all FY-2012 grant applications should be into FAA. Last-minute grants must be executed and returned to FAA by September 15.

- Middle Peninsula Regional Airport: withdrawal of a tentative allocation in the amount of \$64,000.00 that was awarded on February 16, 2012, for the Jet Pod and T-hangar Site Preparation (EA and Design) project
- Williamsburg-Jamestown Airport: 180-day extension of a tentative allocation in the amount of \$360,000.00 that was awarded on February 16, 2012, for the Access Road Rehabilitation (Construction) project
