Mr. Swain provided the quarterly report on the effect of the increased AIP match. For that day's meeting, if the board approved funding based on the department's recommendations, six projects requested under the General Aviation Discretionary fund would not be funded. Mr. Mazza commented on the importance of sponsors meeting deadlines with complete project requests in order to be eligible for funding, especially when available funding is limited.

Mr. Swain provided the quarterly reports on the effect of the increased AIP match and the reimbursed cost of site plan reviews changed by localities. During the last quarter, DOAV reimbursed \$3,160.00 for locality-billed site plan review costs for one project under grant.

Mr. Mazza thanked sponsors and DOAV staff for a great job getting tentative allocations under grant in a timely manner.

Mr. Swain presented the project requests and staff recommendations. The board actions are summarized below. These results are available at www.doav.virginia.gov. After the allocations were awarded, the following state discretionary funds were available:
