Mr. Thys introduced himself as the FAA representative taking over Terry Page's position. He discussed the FY2014 AIP Grant totals (\$88,368,673), FY2015 Outlook, FY20-2018 Capital Improvement Plans also Financial, Safety, Environmental, Planning, Compliance highlights and Standards Operating Procedures.

Mr. Sheller discussed how Dulles Airport is handling Ebola situation they work under CDC guidelines. Michael Cooper, Manager, State and Local Government Affairs, Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority discussed the use of the use of the Transportation Network Companies - Umber, Lift, Sidecar, Umber and the possibilities that other airports in Virginia might be interested in this service.

- 5. New Business
 - a. Smith Mountain Lake Airport Credit Line Deed of Trust

Mr. Burnette presented a request from the new sponsor of the Smith Mountain Lake Airport for a waiver to the appraisal criterion for a credit line deed of trust, which board policy requires in order for grants to be offered to sponsors. Mr. Burnette reviewed the policy as provided in the Airport Program Manual. He also shared supporting information from the sponsor, including the purchase price which was lower than the assessed tax value of the property. DOAV verified the supporting information and the outstanding grant obligations for the airport assumed with the purchase, and then sought legal counsel review of the request. DOAV recommended approval of the appraisal waiver request and the issuance of a credit line deed of trust in the amount of \$468,000.

Ms. McLeskey made a motion to accept staff recommendation. Mr. Inman seconded the motion. The board unanimously approved the motion.

Mr. Oakey made a motion to accept staff recommendations to approve for the Danville Regional Airport: 180-day extension of a tentative allocation in the amount of \$218,246.00 that was awarded on August 15, 2014 for the project Taxiways 'D' & 'E' Connectors Rehabilitation (Construction). The motion was appropriately seconded. The board unanimously approved the motion.

Mr. Oakey made a motion to accept staff recommendations to approve for the Danville Regional Airport: 90-day extension of a tentative allocation in the amount of \$39,600.00 that was awarded on August 15, 2014 for the project Taxilane Rehabilitation (Design) The motion was appropriately seconded. The board unanimously approved the motion.

Ms. McLeskey made a motion to accept staff recommendations to approve for the Newport News-Williamsburg International Airport: 90-day extension of a tentative allocation in the amount of \$1,746,447 (E) and \$1,704,193 (D) that was awarded on August 15, 2014 for the project Security Checkpoint Consolidation (Construction) with the original discretionary tentative allocation of \$2,873,258 being reduced by \$1,169,065. The motion was appropriately seconded. The board unanimously approved the motion.

Mr. Swain provided the quarterly reports on the effect of the increased AIP match and the reimbursed cost of site plan reviews charged by localities. For the November meeting, one project would not be funded due to insufficient funds. During the last quarter, DOAV did not reimburse any funds for site plan reviews.

Mr. Swain presented the project requests and staff recommendations. The board actions are summarized below. These results are available at www.doav.virginia.gov. After the board approved staff recommendations, the following state discretionary funds were available:
