- Virginia Aviation Allocations Review Tentative Allocations from the Commonwealth Airport Fund
  - 1. Impact of Federal Relief Funds

As federal legislation is moving forward with 100 percent funding for AIP projects, staff recommended

- If a sponsor receives a tentative allocation from the Virginia Aviation Boar, and then receives an FAA AIP grant offer for 100% of the project costs, the tentative allocation shall be automatically revoked, and the Department is directed to withdraw the tentative allocation.
- If a sponsor executes a state grant offer, and then receives an FAA AIP grant offer for 100% of the project costs, the sponsor must repay the Department of Aviation for any reimbursements previously received, and the Department of Aviation will close the state grant.
