#### 7. Public Comment Period

Randy Burdette, Chairman

No public comments were offered.

#### 8. Board Member Comments and Reports

Randy Burdette, Chairman

Region 3: Mr. Hall acknowledged Mr. Campbell's one-year anniversary as DOAV director. He suggested that VEDP be consulted on recommendations for the *Airport Program Manual* to help airports compete not only in the Mid-Atlantic region but across the country.

Region 4: Mr. Abbott stated that he had visited the Richmond Executive Airport and learned about current and upcoming projects.

Region 5: Ms. McLeskey stated that she was able to visit the 11 airports in her region in January. She noted that seven percent of women fly and encouraged participation in the Women Can Fly program and announced registration on April 1, 2023. She highlighted upcoming Women Can Fly events at Shannon Airport (4/29/23); Warrenton-Fauquier Airport (6/24/23) and the Military Aviation Museum (9/9/23). She encouraged airports to fly both American and Virginia flags.

Region 6: Mr. Robertson expressed appreciation and noted that he is looking forward to what is in the future.

Region 7: Ms. Christie expressed appreciation for work on projects and congratulations for a successful year. She acknowledged that there is a very big push for commercial air service in the Commonwealth, but there are very diverse perspectives on what incentives are really required to move forward. She noted the importance of understanding what the incentives are to get airlines to the airports. She noted that this will be her focus in the near term.

Director: No comment

Chairman: Mr. Burdette noted that he had visited airports and appreciated the sharing of knowledge that he observed between airports. He stated that he and Director Campbell had visited Aery Aviation, which is a growing opportunity in aviation. He added that he encouraged Aery Aviation's membership in VABA. He stated that he is looking forward to working with VAOC on the program manual.
