The board indorsed the VRA loan request for Middle Peninsula and approved the request for withdrawal and re-allocation of \$20,200.00 from Tazewell.

Dinwiddie County - The board approved the staff recommendation. Mr. Franklin stated that the sponsor would re-bid the proposal in the spring.
