- 7. Board Member Comments and Reports

Mr. Omps informed everyone that the FAA has a website faasafety.gov for anyone flying within 100 nautical miles of DCA you have to take this online test. FAA is requiring this and after completing the test you will be receive a card to be carried at all times.

He also discussed a roof issue at the Winchester Airport. The roof was not build properly and is leaking. The project was bid out but was exceptionally high (\$168,000.00). The airport does not have funding to replace the roof at this time. Repair cost approximately \$21,668.25. Ask that the board appropriate the \$21,000.00 to get started and possible a multi-year grant to cover the rest. Anything that could be done would be most appreciated.

Mr. Franklin expressed concerned about setting a precedence with this airport because there could possible be other airports with the similar problems. If limited funds are available at this time maybe repair as best you can so it will not be a possible safety issue and replace at a later date when funds are available.

The Chairman asked the staff to look at the request to see if this could be funded under the maintenance program and report back at the February 06 meeting.
