A.SpanTran organization memberships and industry background.

B. Specialization in evaluating foreign nursing credentials and course-by-course evaluations.

SpanTran's reports are also used by hundreds of postsecondary nursing programs around the

country for academic admissions purposes. SpanTran evaluators regularly organize professional development sessions covering both international and domestic nursing education to uphold industry standards and improve quality. SpanTran also consults an external committee of experts to periodically review nursing evaluation policies and practices, from intake to delivery.

SpanTran: The Evaluation Company provides course-by-course assessments of international transcripts, academic degrees, and professional licensure credentials, equated to comparable credit hours, grades, G.P.A., and degrees within the context of the United States higher education system. The Nursing Course Analysis report includes an evaluation of the applicant's academic credential and the applicant's professional license. The evaluation of the academic credential includes identifying information describing the credential and the institution attended, a review of institutional/programmatic accreditation, and an equivalency statement comparing the program to an approved nursing program or prelicensure nursing education program in the United States. The evaluation report can include equivalency statements for both high school and postsecondary credentials. The report also provides a postsecondary course-by-course breakdown of each course taken with the course level indicated as follows: L = lower level (required prerequisites and entry-level undergraduate coursework), U = upper level (advanced-level undergraduate coursework), and G = graduate level (beyond undergraduate level coursework). Nursing Course Analysis reports include a calculation of U.S. credit hours, grades, and a cumulative G.P.A out of 4. Furthermore, the evaluation lists the nurse's clinical experience by rotation or specialty/subspecialty, expressed in clock hours.

SpanTran reviews and verifies foreign nurse licensure for authenticity and comparability to first or second-level nurse licensure in the United States. Our reports include pertinent licensure details along with a statement of equivalency. This provides a complete picture and supplements the nurse's academic analysis.

C. SpanTran's translation services.

SpanTran: The Evaluation Company provides certified translations for a wide range of foreign languages into English and has been a corporate member of the American Translators Association (ATA) since 2018 (member #272267). The certified translations are issued along with the official evaluation reports and all pertinent original source documents, application materials, completed nursing forms, etc. directly to the applicant and to the designated nursing board.

D. Verification methods and notification of fraudulent documents.

SpanTran: The Evaluation Company has been proactively verifying applicant documents for over 40 years. SpanTran joined the National Association of Credential Evaluation Services (NACES®) as a regular member in 1996. It is our duty to notify the Board immediately and in writing in the event that any of the applicant's documents are found to be fraudulent. We will not release any evaluation reports until all credentials and licenses are confirmed to be authentic.

SpanTran does not knowingly evaluate falsified or altered documents. In cases of confirmed forgeries, SpanTran shares this information with NACES member organizations and notifies other entities as deemed appropriate.

Nurses are made aware that all foreign studies and licensure history must be verified for authenticity. SpanTran verifies all post-secondary documents and nursing licensure. Verifying all post-secondary documents with the issuing institution abroad is a standard policy and requirement for every evaluation we do. (Refer to Section "I" for a more detailed explanation of SpanTran's anti-fraud practices).

E. References used in evaluation.

SpanTran: The Evaluation Company references years of extensive in-house research, multiple onsite international education libraries, external print and web sources, international education databases such as EDGE, ECCTIS, and Nuffic databases, foreign ministerial, governmental and institutional publications and websites, and more. F. Language of nursing instruction and education.

SpanTran: The Evaluation Company indicates the language of nursing education and will include the language of textbooks for nursing education on the evaluation report (Refer to Exhibit B - Kentucky & Texas Samples, Exhibit C- Translated materials).

For programs not taught in English. SpanTran will accept and collect English Language Proficiency exams as required by the Virginia Board of Nursing.

G. Documentation used in evaluating nursing education.

SpanTran: The Evaluation Company bases its reports solely on original source documentation in evaluating nursing education. This includes degree certificates, diplomas, transcripts, and other academic and clinical documents issued by foreign nursing institutions and nursing authorities. A copy of all original source documentation pertaining to each evaluation case will be provided to the Virginia BON (Refer to Exhibits A, B, C).

SpanTran verifies all academic and license credentials for authenticity.

<u>Academic Credential Verification</u>: Students arrange for their university to send SpanTran their documents directly. Students ask the registrar's office at their foreign university to submit their official academic and clinical transcripts, along with SpanTran's 'Transcript Request' form. SpanTran accepts mailed copies or emailed copies of these documents.

Emailed copies must come directly through an official institutional email account, complete with the sender's name, job title, and department. Email submissions from public domains (e.g. @gmail.com, @yahoo.com, @mail.ru) are not accepted. This includes the use of software to catch spoofing and ensure that the information received can be verified on the issuing institutions/nursing authority's website."

As an alternative, the nurse can mail the form and transcript in an official, sealed institutional envelope directly to: SpanTran: The Evaluation Company, 2400 Augusta Drive, Suite 451, Houston, TX 77057. Documents cannot be mailed by the nurse, a relative, or any other party. The "Sender" field on the shipping label or envelope must clearly show the name of the foreign academic institution's address.

SpanTran has a database of thousands of foreign institutions, documents, and contacts from abroad to help us ensure that the documents we're getting are authentic and from the correct department in charge of student records.

<u>License Verification:</u> SpanTran can verify licenses using two main methods: national databases and closed loop communications.

- National and Regional Databases

SpanTran does not discriminate on the basis of race, disability, religion, gender, national origin, or age. However, as a private company not supported by any governmental or public funds, SpanTran retains the right to decline to provide services according to internal business practices and policies.

SpanTran retains evaluations and translations for five years from the date of file initiation. Questions regarding completed services must be submitted in writing within 30 calendar days of the date the evaluation was issued. Questions submitted after 30 calendar days must be submitted in writing, and accompanied by a non-refundable revision fee of \$50.00. This fee covers administrative costs and does not guarantee that any modifications will be made to the evaluation.

Credential Evaluation Policies

The U.S. government does not set standards for the evaluation of foreign educational credentials. SpanTran bases its evaluations on extensive in-house research, information gained through participation in professional development opportunities, and on-line and print resources. SpanTran is a member of NACES[®] but evaluation methodologies and outcomes vary among NACES member organizations. The total number of quality points are then divided by the total number of attempted credits. SpanTran lists the equivalent grade per course, including failures, incomplete, withdrawn, and pass grades. Failures are included in grade point average calculation. In cases of pass/fail grades, pass grades are awarded credit but not factored into the grade point average. If a specific course is attempted multiple times, the evaluation only includes the first and final attempts. The cumulative grade point average/CGPA will reflect both grades.
