CLOSED MEETING: Dr. Werth moved that the Board convene a closed meeting pursuant to § 2.2-3711(A)(27) of the *Code of Virginia* for the purpose of deliberation to reach a decision in the matter of David Ribbe. Additionally, he moved that James Rutkowski, Jennifer Lang, and Christy Evans attend the meeting because their presence was deemed necessary and would aid the Board in its deliberations. RECONVENE: Having certified that the matters discussed in the preceding closed meeting met the requirements of § 2.2-3712 of the Code, the Board reconvened in open meeting.

DECISION: Upon a motion by Ms. Little, and duly seconded by Dr. Wallace, the Board voted that, in consideration of the evidence presented, Dr. Ribbe's continued practice as a clinical psychologist poses a substantial danger to the public and the license shall be summarily suspended pending a formal hearing. The vote was unanimous.

Further, upon a motion by Dr. Vauter, and duly seconded by Dr. Wallace, the board voted to offer Dr. Ribbe a Consent Order for revocation in lieu of a formal hearing. The vote was unanimous.

With all business concluded, the Board adjourned at 1:53 p.m.
