Nursing Facility Price-based Reimbursement

12VAC30-90-44 *Nursing facility price-based reimbursement methodology*

 Prospective price-based rates are calculated using provider <u>cost report data</u>, <u>inflation</u>, and <u>CMS-wage</u> <u>index data + VDH licensing report</u> (for mapping)

Five cost report data categories:

Data Sources:

- Nursing Facility Cost Reports
- Case Mix data from the CMS Minimum Data Set survey instrument
- Virginia Specific Nursing Facility Inflation from IHS Markit
- VDH Licensing Data (Peer Group Validation)
- CMS Wage Index Data FFY 23-FR (Peer Group Validation)



Data Sources: inflation

SFY 24 Nursing Facility Inflation is <u>6.33%</u>

Year	Inflation
2020	2.90%
2021	4.10%
2022	5.90%
2023	14.70%
2024	6.33%

Assumptions

- All allowable costs are included in the final cost report data and providers have filed their cost reports correctly.
- Providers that did not submit cost data will get the statewide average for Criminal Records Checks rate.
- Providers that did not submit cost data will get \$0.00 for NATCEP.
- Providers that do not submit capital costs will get a capital rate of \$0.00.

Rate Calculation Process

- 1. Direct and Indirect Operating rates are inflated
- Facility Peer Groups are validated using VDH Licensing data and CMS Wage Index Data
- Criminal Records Check rates are developed using cost data
- 4. Capital rates are developed using cost data
- NATCEP rates are developed using <u>cost data</u> and <u>inflated</u>



Summary of Nursing Facility Reimbursement

- Nursing facility direct and indirect base rates will be inflated 6.33% in FY24
- Criminal records checks and capital will be updated with cost reports
- NATCEP will be updated with cost reports and inflation
