Regulations - Human Research The Board approved the request to publish for public

comment Proposed Amendment to the Regulations to Assure the Protection of Participants in Human Research -

12 VAC 35-180-10 et seq., with proposed changes.

Regulations - Licensing The Board approved the request to publish for public comment

Proposed Regulations for the Licensing of Providers of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services, 12 VAC 35-105-10 et seq. which incorporate provisions for the licensing providers of the Individual and Family Developmental

Disabilities and Support (IFDDS) Waiver.

Grant Application Randy Koch presented a grant application "Current Status and

Future Directions of Children Evidence Based Practices in Virginia." The Board approved the submission of the grant

application.

Commissioner's Report Dr. Reinhard reported on a number of items including the

reinvestment from facilities to the CSB's. There is no plan to close facilities which would continue to provide inpatient beds. This would result in less cost, shorter stays (with the same quality of

treatment) and more patients being served.

General Assembly.

Olmstead Task Force Charline Davison presented an update on the activities of the

Olmstead Task Force.
