## Enforcement Committee Meeting Minutes January 9, 2008

The Virginia Board of Accountancy's Enforcement Committee met on Wednesday, January 9, 2008, at 9960 Mayland Drive, Perimeter Center, Second Floor Conference Center, in Hearing Room1, Richmond, Virginia 23233

The following members of the Committee were present:

There were no members of the public in attendance

The meeting convened at 9:35 a.m.

The Enforcement Committee opened the meeting with respect to Agenda Item A, review of the written procedures for the unintentional violation of unlicensed activity cases. It was unanimously agreed that after a minor amendment to this document, this procedure can be forwarded to the full Board for approval at the next Board meeting.

With respect to agenda item B, the Committee reviewed the requested Sanctions Checklist and determined that it shall remain under review to be deferred until the next E. C. meeting.

The Committee discussed the proposed draft of the Cross Jurisdictional Investigation Policy and after the addition of a brief statement the policy was deemed ready for approval at the next full Board meeting. A date was agreed upon for the next EC meeting for February 15, 2008. With respect to Agenda Item D, a review of open disciplinary cases were discussed in closed session.

Upon a motion by Ms. Calderone, and seconded by Mr. Dickerson, the Committee approved by unanimous vote that the meeting be recessed and that the Committee immediately reconvene in closed session for the purpose of consultation on Committee matters within the jurisdiction of the Board as permitted by § 2.2-3711 A.28 of the *Code of Virginia*.
