## Enforcement Committee Meeting Minutes June 3, 2008

The Virginia Board of Accountancy's Enforcement Committee met on Tuesday, June 3, 2008, at 9960 Mayland Drive, Perimeter Center, Second Floor Conference Center, Hearing Room 2, Richmond, Virginia 23233
