complete work and misconduct. Final Order 2009-00639 resulted in fines of \$900 and assignment to remedial education. Compliance was obtained on October 14, 2009.

On April 19, 2011, JES Construction LLC was found in violation of the Board for Contractors Regulations for having been disciplined by the Virginia Department of Agriculture and Consumer Affairs. Consent Order 2011-03201 resulted in fines of no fines, \$150 in Board costs and assignment to remedial education. Compliance was obtained on July 19, 2011.

On March 3, 2015, JES Construction LLC was found in violation of the Board for Contractors Regulations for failure to pull a permit and negligence or incompetence. Consent Order 2014-03361 resulted in fines of \$3,500, \$150 Board costs and assignment to remedial education. Compliance was obtained on April 30, 2015.

On June 2, 2015, JES Construction LLC was found in violation of the Board for Contractors Regulations for failure to have all elements required in a residential contract, failure to pull a permit, and failure to complete. Consent Order 2015-00716 resulted in fines of \$2,000, \$150 Board costs and assignment to remedial education. Compliance was obtained on August 12, 2015.

On October 20, 2015, JES Construction LLC was found in violation of the Board for Contractors Regulations failure to make prompt delivery of a contract, failure to use a change order and failure to pull a permit. Consent Order 2015-01333 resulted in fines of \$2,650 and \$150 Board costs. Compliance was obtained on January 8, 2016.

On March 1, 2016, JES Construction LLC was found in violation of the Board for Contractors Regulations for failure to pull a permit. Consent Order 2015-03007 resulted in fines of \$1,000 and \$150 Board costs. Compliance was obtained on April 18, 2016.

On November 8, 2016, JES Construction LLC was found in violation of the Board for Contractors Regulations for two violations of failure to pull a permit. Final Order 2015-03188 resulted in fines of \$5,000 and assignment to remedial education. Compliance was obtained on June 16, 2021. The delay in compliance resulted from an appeal.
