Examinations and remote proctoring update

Examinations and remote proctoring update

Marjorie King, Executive Director, informed the Committee: Remote proctoring of examinations has gone live. Statistics will be provided at the 3, 6, and 9 month markings for review. Ms. King also noted that the Board has been asked to complete a review of its examination questions for all the classifications, specialty's, business law exams, and the pass rates by the end of the year. Ms. King informed the Committee that the Education Providers will have until January 2025 to update their courses.

Petition for Rulemaking

Petition for Rulemaking

Marjorie King, Executive Director, informed the Committee: Section 2.2-4007 of the Administrative Process Act (APA) (§ 2.2-4000 et seq. of the Code of Virginia) allows for any person to "...petition an agency to request the agency to develop a new regulation or amend an existing regulation." The APA requires that upon receipt of a petition, the agency must submit a notice of the petitioner's request and the agency's plan for disposition of the petition to the Registrar within 14 days of receipt. The APA further requires that a 21-day period for acceptance of written public comment be provided following publication in the Virginia Register of

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Regulations.

At its March 12, 2024, meeting, the Board received a petition to amend 18VAC50-30-190 of the Individual License and Certification Regulations.

On April 22, 2024, the petition was published in the Virginia Register of Regulations. The public comment period on the petition concluded on May 13, 2024, during which, the Board received comments on the petition. The petition and comments received are attached as Exhibits 1 and 2, respectively.

Section 2.2-4007 of the Code of Virginia requires the Board to issue a written decision to grant or deny the petitioner's request. The written decision issued by the Board must include a statement of its reasons and must be submitted for publication in the Virginia Register.

Mr. McGonegal made a motion, seconded by Mr. Spencer to deny the petition requesting amendment to the Individual License and Certification Regulations. This decision aligns with the statutes and regulations of the Board, which are designed to safeguard the health, safety, and welfare of the public. Amending the regulation as the petitioner has requested would fail to uphold the Board's duty to ensure these protections.
