DPOR is funded through licensing fees. The Code of Virginia requires DPOR Boards to establish fees that are sufficient to cover their operating expenses. During the 2010's, the Board for Contractors, along with several other DPOR boards, brought in more revenue than was necessary and ended up with several million dollars surplus. The 2019 General Assembly directed DPOR to spend down its surplus cash reserve through filling vacancies and upgrading its antiquated licensing and enforcement systems. Over the past few years, DPOR has filled vacancies and started development of a new licensing system, which has spent down that cash reserve.

Currently, the Board is operating at a loss of about \$1 million annually and is expected to exhaust its cash reserve in the next fiscal year. To ensure DPOR and the Board have sufficient funds to continue operating, a fee increase is necessary. The Board's last fee increase was in April of 2010. There has been 44% inflation since April of 2010 and Board costs have increased during that time as well. Staff are recommending a fee increase of approximately 33%. This will provide sufficient revenue to cover all the

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board's operating and anticipated expenses. We believe this will ensure adequate, but not excessive, revenue for the next decade.

Louisiana Examination Reciprocity

This letter serves as notice of the change in requirements for examination reciprocity with the Louisiana State Licensing Board for Contractors effective immediately.

Going forward, if an applicant/licensee/registrant holds a classification that requires a test in any other state, and they have passed that test – with no waivers, exemptions, or grandfathering in effect – the LSLBC will accept that passing exam for reciprocity. The exam will be accepted for the classification chosen by the LSLBC and will be equivalent in nature. All other requirements for licensure must be met, including the investigation of all violations or pending violations.

This change in procedure renders any previous agreements null and void. We believe this new method is less restrictive and will be beneficial to all licensees.
