Business Agreement Updates

CE Waiver Updates

Ms. Nosbisch reported that the discussion of a plumbing exam option within the mechanical engineer exam was discussed at the September meeting. Since that meeting, ten states have agreed to the addition of the plumbing exam option within the mechanical engineering exam, and NCEES is taking steps to move forward with exploring the addition of this exam. NCEES has asked if the Board would offer the exam if/when offered. Mr. Stone moved to approve offering the plumbing exam option within the mechanical engineer exam when available. Ms. Stokes seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by: Alexander, Alexandria, Allen, Anglin, Colley, Hancock, Kelly, Nair, Price, Snetter, Stiles, Stokes, Stone, and Zmuda.

Discussion of Plumbing Exam Option Within Mechanical Engineer Exam

At the September 1, 2020 meeting, the Board asked for follow-up information on instances of fraudulent use of a seal. In 2018 an architect was issued an electronic architect seal in error which he used. He was charged with violation of 18VAC10-20-790.8. This is for informational purposes only. There were no instances of fraud regarding the use of seals.

Instances of Fraudulent Use of Seal

Ms. Mimi Kronisch, PE, CCM, partner of RK&K explained some engineers applying for comity in Virginia have been denied to sit for the exam because a majority of their experience was construction management. She stated that this is not an issue when apply for comity in North Carolina, Maryland or Washington D.C. Ms. Kronisch pointed out the conflicts of regulations 18VAC10-20-240 and 18VAC10-20-160. A discussion took place regarding construction management experience.

Professional Engineer Section Update

SCC Virginia Transportation

Mr. Stone represented the Board on the Virginia State Corporation Commission Division of Utility and Railroad Safety Stakeholders Group. Regulations have been proposed and public comment was last month.

Safety Board Update

There was nothing new to report at this time.

Land Surveyor Section Update

Ms. Nobsch reported elections will be held at the Southern Zone meeting on April 15th. The last Control Systems paper and pencil exam will be in October. The Centennial was last year, they will be observing it this year at the annual meeting in New Orleans in August.

NCEES Update

There was nothing new to report at this time.

Landscape Architect Section Update

Ms. Nobsch discussed CLARB's rethink initiative, friction analysis, and uniform applications on which they will no longer be requiring references.

CLARB Update

There was nothing new to report at this time.

Architect Section Update

Ms. Nobsch reported the NCARB Regional Summit was last week; the Annual meeting will probably be hybrid June 24-26. A Special Resolution meeting will be held May 12-14.

NCARB Update

There was nothing new to report at this time.

Certified Interior Designer Section Update

Ms. Nobsch stated the current CIDQ leadership positions of president elect and two directors must be filled by Certified Interior Designers. Applications must be received by April 23rd.

CIDQ Update

Ms. Broz-Vaughan stated DPOR received no new programs nor were any existing programs deregulated.

2021 General Assembly Update

Ms. Nobsch reported that the Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission

(JLARC) had requested the Board for Professional and Occupation Regulation (BPOR) provide a report on the need for continued regulation of seven professions, including certified interior designers and landscape architects. The report was filed on December 17, 2020 to the General Assembly. No bills have been put forth that affected any of the seven professions.

Board for Professional and Occupation Regulation (BPOR) December 17, 2020 Final Report

Ms. Nobsch reported that the fee adjustment which was filed in September is at the Secretary's Office. The revised regulations are in the final stage at the Secretary's Office.
