### **Beverly Pearce**

Dear Mr. Olson and other Board Members.

During the public comments of your June 21 meeting, a letter was read by an attorney representing a couple named David and Carol Cavanaugh, expressing concerns that the merits of their complaint to DPOR against a contractor who had harmed them financially and otherwise, had not been addressed—in spite of ample evidence of serious violations.

I had the exact same experience.

I filed complaint 2021-02861 with DPOR against septic installation contractor Larry Royston on June 17th of last year, and received a response from your board on July 2 of this year. This included a consent order that Mr. Royston had signed admitting to licensing-irregularity violations, and agreeing to pay a \$950 fine and complete a remedial education course.

Oddly, these violations had nothing to do with the substance of my complaint. In fact, your employees discovered them during the investigation, and I did not see them until receiving the final consent order.

The items that were matters of my complaint included

- performing work without a contract
- · installing a septic system out of compliance with engineering specifications
- · performing work near Virginia waterways without erosion control measures
- · causing property damage
- · and after the work had ended-threatening to trespass and sabotage the septic equipment

I provided full photographic and written documentation of all of these to your investigator. Yet it appears they were ignored. It would be totally understandable if an investigation revealed that a citizen's complaints were unfounded. In such a case, the conclusion and proof should be provided to the person filling the complaint. However, to completely ignore them raises serious questions—such as what transpired that would cause fully-documented allegations to be set aside, and instead replaced with completely unrelated violations?

After the consent letter came in, my attorney sent your board a letter inquiring about this. He received no response.

I understand that you as a board don't have time to hear every detail of every complaint, but the DPOR website states that you enforce standards of professional conduct. If there is an inadequate process in place for citizens' complaints to even be addressed, there is reason for serious concern.

Like the Cavanaughs, my purpose of filing the complaint was to prevent others from receiving the same unprofessional treatment. The resolution I received does not allow that to happen.

In conclusion, I respectfully request two things, that you:

- 1. reopen and re-examine my complaint #2021-02861, and
- 2. put into place a process that ensures transparency, and that the public's concerns are fully and fairly addressed. Lacking this, the process does not protect the public. It protects contractors at the public's expense.

Thank you, and I look forward to hearing back from you.
