Mr. Kirschner also reviewed the Hearing Aid Specialists and Opticians examination statistics with the Board for all exams administered between August and November 2017.

Mr. Kirschner reported that the Hearing Aid Specialist fee adjustment remains in the Executive Branch/Governor's Office for review.

**Old Business** 

**Regulations – HAS Fee Adjustment** 

Mr. Melis advised the Board of the meeting of the Optician Examination Committee on November 1, 2017, indicating that the Committee was provided an overview of the RFP process, and had nominated Ms. Canty and Ms. Rogers to serve on the DPOR exam procurement committee. Mr. Melis further indicated the RFP is anticipated to completed by the end of February with proposals from potential exam vendors to be reviewed by mid-summer 2018.

**Committee on Optician Examinations Report** 

Mr. Melis advised the Board of the OTC Hearing Aid Act of 2017, and stated that the FDA will be developing regulations to implement the Act making OTC hearing devices available to the public. Mr. Melis stated the regulatory process will likely be lengthy, roughly

approximating a minimum of two years to complete. He further advised the Board that Virginia Code states that hearing aid devices must be dispensed by a licensed hearing aid specialist, and that staff will be consulting with counsel to interpret the Act.

Mr. Melis conducted an overview of the examination procurement process.
