Within 6 months from the date of entry of the Order, Dr. Willoughby shall successfully complete an 8 credit hour continuing education course in the subject of principles of endodontic diagnosis and treatment; a 3 credit hour course in the subject of dental recordkeeping; and a 7 credit hour course in the subject of proper dental accounting, coding, and billing for her and the office staff.
