Regarding File Number 2011-04770, Atlantic Asset Management Group, Inc. t/a Accelerated Auction Remarketing, the Board members reviewed the Consent Order as seen and agreed to by Accelerated Auction Remarketing. Ms. Bennett moved to accept the Consent Order which cites the following violations of the Board's regulations: 18VAC25-21-150.D (Count 1); and 18VAC25-21-180.4 (Count 2). For these violations, Accelerated Auction Remarketing agrees to the following sanctions: \$500.00 for the violation contained in Count 1; \$1,500.00 for the violation contained in Count 2; and \$150.00 in Board costs. For a total monetary penalty of \$2,150.00. Ms. Wang seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by members: Bennett, Bryant and Wang. Former Board member Samuel K. (Buddy) Updike was the presiding officer.

Mr. Lief, Board Counsel, stated that it would be in their best interest to seek advice from counsel. It would depend on how the will and the executor's role was set up. Mr. Courtney stated they would need to be in compliance with 18VAC25-21-120.
