<b>Brief Overview</b> Authorizes political subdivisions to regulate take-offs and landing of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV) on properties owned by the political subdivision, as required by the General Assembly 2020 session House Bill 742. The proposed action amends 24VAC5-20.
