Dear Director Paylor:

I have reviewed the amendments to the above-referenced regulations. It is my opinion that the State Water Control Board has authority to promulgate the amendments to the regulations under applicable law including Chapter 3.1 of Title 62.1 of the Code of Virginia. It is also my view that the amendments are exempt from Article 2 of the Administrative Process Act pursuant to Va. Code § 2.2-4006(A)(4)(a).
