RE: Review of Proposed Regulations for reissuance of Virginia Pollutant Discharge Elimination System General Permit Regulation for Storm Water Discharges Associated with Industrial Activity — 9 VAC 25-151

In response to a request from the Department of Environmental Quality, I reviewed the above-referenced regulations of the State Water Control Board.

The State Water Control Board has the authority to amend its regulations. *See* Va. Code § 62.1-44.15 of the Code of Virginia. Based on my review of the proposed regulations, it is my opinion that the State Water Control Board has the authority to so amend and reissue 9 VAC 25-151. It is also my opinion that the proposed regulations are for a general permit and, therefore, exempt from Article 2 of the Administrative Process Act pursuant to Va. Code § 2.2-4006(A)(8).
